

HANSEN, KAMMER SHARE BOWLER OF YEAR HONORS

Battle throughout season ends in epic draw



Two of the IAA's most prolific bowlers share top honors for the 2003-04 season. Scott Hansen and Bob Kammer Jr separated themselves from the other top echelon IAA bowlers early in the season and continued to do so throughout the season, however, they could not separate themselves from each other culminating in a showdown for the ages in the Wednesday Men's championship rollofs. Hansen, averaged 232 in the Wednesday Mens, notched the IAA's season high series, 835, and posted three 300 games. Hansen's tournament performance also included top five finishes in the World Team Challenge, Master's, and Doubles championships. Kammer Jr averaged 230, rolled three award scores, and claimed the IAA Doubles



title. Kammer's World Team Challenge team garnered second place. Joining the "heavyweights" on the all-IAA team are Brian Betts, Keith Betts, and Tim Woloszyn. This represents the first time both Brian Betts and Tim Woloszyn have been named to the all-star unit.
