

***Inland Athletic Association
Outstanding Supplier Recognition Awards***

The administrative budget will include \$500 for member & outstanding supplier recognition awards. Outstanding supplier awards will be presented to suppliers who contribute to the betterment of the Inland Athletic Association in an outstanding fashion. Contributions may be in the form of pricing below market, longevity (more than just a one-time deal), services provided beyond “pricing”, and future relationship/IAA needs.

1. Eligibility: Any vendor/supplier or establishment that services the IAA.
2. Written nominations must be submitted to the board of directors. This should include a description of the nominee, services provided and the impact on the activity or association.
3. Nominations must be received by November 1st . The IAA Secretary will accept nominations throughout the calendar year.
4. The Board of Directors will make determination of recipients prior to the December meeting.
5. Individuals submitting nominations, may, attend the November board meeting to further describe the merits of the nominee. The Board will have an open discussion regarding all nominees at the November meeting.
6. Awards will be presented at the annual board of director’s Christmas dinner. Both the recipient and individual submitting the nomination (if different) will be invited to this dinner.
7. Awards will be made in the form of a recognition plaque to be displayed at their place of business.
8. Suppliers will be limited to (1) major award.
9. The allowed budget of \$500 may or may not be fully allocated. However, any unused budget will not carry forward.

This policy is in effect as of January 1, 1999. Annual modification to/review of this policy will be conducted on an as-appropriate basis (determined by the current residing Board). Alterations to this policy will enter into effect January 1 of the following year.
