

## Patterson's 69 Tops Largest Field of Year

Chet Patterson navigated South Shore Country Club and mother nature's blustery conditions in a convincing 1-under par 69 to edge Dale Vecheby by a single stroke. Vecheby toured the outward nine in a staggering 3-under 33 before succumbing with bogies on 15 and 16, allowing Patterson to grab top honors in the field of 148 IAA golfers. Jim Mohoi and Frank Sapyta shared third with 76's, while Jerry Novak and Nate Staten rounded out the top five with solid 77's.

Lisa Misch and Rose Ceperich tied for top ladies honors with 96's, setting up an epic battle for ladies supremacy at the September finals at Aberdeen as they have topped all IAA lady competitors this season.

Skins were won by Reggie Woody and Rich Nallenweg. Woody's birdie on the short par 3 fifth was worth \$210 while Nallenweg's birdie on the difficult par 4 sixth garnered the remaining \$210. Birdies on all other holes halved with the exception of #4, where, none of 82 participants could break par, and #12 where two eagles were carded.

The finals are slated for September 21st at Aberdeen with well over 100 expected to partake. Champions will be crowned in 10 different classes, including two senior and two ladies divisions.
