GOLF GETAWAY WEEKEND RETURNS TO LOWER MICHIGAN

August 17-19

The 2007 IAA Golf Getaway weekend will return to the Greater Kalamazoo area in southwestern Michigan for the third consecutive year August 17 through 19th. IAA golfers will test their skills against some of the area's finest courses, including Golf Digest's highly rated Angels Crossing. In addition, golfers will have the opportunity to make it a three day weekend by challenging the acclaimed Stonehedge South, Stonehedge North, and Gull Lake View East courses, all belonging to the Gull Lake View Resort family.

This year's base package includes two nights lodging at the Lee's Inn (Kalamazoo), 18 holes with cart at Angels Crossing, 18 holes with Cart at the Stonehedge South, and 18 holes with Cart at Gull Lake View East, breakfast both days, and barbeque lunch following golf on Sunday. Numerous door prizes will be distributed as well. Beer and pop will be provided at the Saturday evening poker tournament at the hotel. The base package will be priced at \$260 based on double occupancy(\$220 based on quad occupancy). The following additions can be made:

SVILAR, MIKALOUSKI: 2007 DOUBLES CHAMPIONS

Mike Svilar and Kevin Mikalouski finished with games of 265, 236, 245, and 262 to qualify as the second seed behind qualifying leaders Rob Stubblefield and Steve Peterson. But it was all Svilar and Mikalouski as the two top seeds advanced through matchplay to face-off in the title match. Mikalouski, the 2006 champion, and Svilar rolled games of 244 and 236 in the finale to claim the title and \$450 first place prize. Other finalists included Keith Anderson and Eric Sarcady, Tony Vaupal and Ron Cimoch, Manny Alvarado and Steve Hoshaw, and Troy Davis and Todd Moffett. Sarcady and Anderson used a huge 259 sixth game to jump Kathi and Rick Tucker for the final qualifying spot.

The event attracted 28 teams to Hebron Lanes January 28th, 2007. High games were captured by Hoshaw - Alvarado, Vaupal - Cimoch, Stubblefield - Peterson (2), Mike Kraushaar - Rick Podkul, and Mike Cauthran - George Clarke.
