- 5) **DEADLINE TO APPLY:** May 25, 2011 (we must be in receipt of the "IAA 2011 Scholarship Entry Form" [see below] by May 25 (not postmarked by May 25.))

*Senior must be enrolled for Fall, 2011 semester.

The one-time scholarship will be awarded to four recipients. The winners of these awards will be picked randomly by a lottery system. Once we have received the entries and the most recent transcript of grades, we will review to verify all criteria have been met and then select the winners. Winners will be notified by the end of May. The checks will be payable to the institution the student will be attending in Fall, 2011. Checks for graduating high school seniors will be issued at the end of the first semester after student has completed the semester with at least a C+ average.
