Ski Club

Inland Ski Club has been in existence for over 35 adventurous, fun filled years. If *you* are a skier or snowboarder looking for a group to ski with, or just someone who likes to have fun, join up.

In addition to being a member of IAA, the ski club is a member of the Chicago Metropolitan Ski Council (CMSC), which consists of around 70 ski clubs from throughout the Midwest. They offer the club additional options for ski trips and other activities. One of these trips next season is a European ski and touring trip to Madonna di Campiglio, Italy from January 21 – 29, 2012 with an extension to Venice, Italy that runs through February 1.

The ski club has not finalized its 2011 – 2012 ski season trip schedule yet, but one trip that is set is the “CMSC Chicago Week” ski trip to Steamboat, Colorado February 25 to March 3. The club will be joining over 300 participants from other CMSC clubs for a week of skiing and partying. The cost of the trip is \$1350, and a \$300 deposit will be due at the club’s September 9 meeting. This cost includes air from Chicago to Denver, ground transportation from Denver to Steamboat, lodging in 2 bedroom condominiums that are at the base of the ski lifts, and all the parties and racing activities being planned by the CMSC.
